- Evidence of scholarly activity or strong potential for scholarly contributions.
- Ph.D will be an added advantage.

2: English

The successful candidate will have:

- Master's degree in English or Linguistics or Modern Languages or a closely related field
- A formal certificate of training as an English language teacher
- Previous teaching experience in a similar role would be an added advantage.
- Ph.D. will be an added advantage

Further Details for all positions

- It is essential that candidates should demonstrate competence in the language relevant to the areas of specialization.
- Candidates must be highly motivated to work for the vision of Nalanda University.
- Candidates are expected to contribute to tasks in the School and University
- Candidates must have an ability to work collegially with faculty members drawn internationally with diverse disciplinary interests.
